


**CORRIGENDOM REGARDING DECISION OF THE AUTHORITY IN THE MATTER OF

PROCEDURE) RULES, 1998 WITH RESPECT TO RECOMMENDATION OF THE CONSUMER  
END TARIFF OF XWDISCOs AND K-ELECTRIC**


1. The Authority has observed that in its decision dated July 25, 2023 issued vide No. NEPRA/R/ADG(Tariff)/TRF- 100/19271-19290 in in the matter of motion filed by the Federal Government under section 7 and 31(7) of the nepra act 1997 read with rule 17 of the nepra (tariff standards and procedure) rules, 1998 with respect to recommendation of the consumer end tariff of XWDISCOs and K-Electric, an amendment is required. Accordingly, the Authority has decided to replace the tariff table along with notes in "Annex-C" for General Supply Tariff- Residential, with following table and notes.


For NEPRA determined tariff as per Authority's decision residential consumers will be given the benefit of only one previous slab.  
For NEPRA determined tariff as per Authority's decision residential life line consumers will not be given any slab benefit.  
For NEPRA determined tariff as per Authority's decision for one slab benefit in the un-protected residential consumer category slabs from 201-700, the slab rates of 201-300 slab would be used for previous slab benefit upto 300 units.  
For the purpose of GoP applicable variable charges only protected residential consumers will be given the benefit of only one previous slab.  
For the purpose of GoP applicable variable charges residential life line consumers will not be given any slab benefit.  
Under tariff A-1, there shall be minimum monthly customer charge at the following rates even if no energy is consumed:  
a) Single Phase Connections: Rs. 75/- per consumer per month  
b) Three Phase Connections: Rs. 100/- per consumer per month


